**B**ased on over twenty years of teaching and constant feedback from today's generation of young people, Rosalind Wiseman's presentation is a call for action to transform the way we understand young people and create communities where children can thrive. From young people's friendships, bullying, anxiety, social media use, conflicts with friends and family, and the constant pressure to "keep up," she'll share how we can best connect with young people; especially now when they need us most. She'll give concrete advice for us so we, in turn, can guide the young people in our care while avoiding the common communication breakdowns and power struggles that often occur between young people and adults.

We'll also hear from a young woman who has had first-hand experience with interpersonal conflict and learn of her efforts to navigate through both the conflict itself and the stigma attached to it.
